WHAT IS STEWARDSHIP?

STEWARDSHIP, Greek in "Oikonomia" means "the Management of the House." In the Church, it refers to the fiscal practice assuring of that current spending programs are affordable and sustainable over time, as well as the effort to maximize and develop our parish resources. Stewardship is a way of life for the Orthodox, in which we offer our Time, Talents, and Treasure in appreciation and in proportion to the blessings God bestows on us. It is our common duty as stewards to help manage our spiritual house, Saint Nicholas. *It is* through our stewardship that we are able to provide:

- The ongoing functioning of ALL Church ministries & events
- The ability to fulfill our parish's vision & Christ's Great Commission
- A greater sense of parish ownership & pride among the faithful

The Benefits of Being a Steward

As the "good and faithful servant" who we read about in Matthew 25:21, when we cheerfully embrace stewardship, we position ourselves to "enter into the joy of [our] Master." This Christ-centered approach to our lives allows us to remain mindful of God and His blessings, and makes us more receptive to them in the future. *Being a steward also allows one to:*

- Be included in all parish communications and invited to all events.

- Be considered an "Orthodox Christian in Good Standing," which permits him/her to vote in Parish Assemblies, hold parish leadership positions, and act in liturgical roles (ie. being a Godparent/Sponsor).
