

THE TEST

Tests aren't just for school. Sometimes we face important tests in life, when we must decide the right thing to do. Why did Chris say he didn't know Joy, and how did she feel?

Have you ever pretended not to know someone because you were embarrassed or afraid?



How did Jesus warn Simon Peter about the test he would face? [Read Luke 22:31-33.](#)

What did Peter do when Jesus was arrested?
[Read Matthew 26:57-58.](#)

Why was Peter so afraid? [Read Matthew 26:59.](#)

How many times did Peter deny that he knew Jesus, and how did he feel afterward? [Read Matthew 26:69-75.](#)

PRAY

Heavenly Father, whenever I face a test in my life, please give me Your power and courage to do the right thing. In Jesus' name, Amen.

THE QUESTION

Peter may have thought he was a failure as Jesus was led away to die, but that wasn't the end of the story! What happened to Jesus after He was crucified?

Read [Romans 5:8-11](#).

Later, in Galilee, what did Jesus ask Peter?

Read [John 21:15-17](#). Why do you think Jesus asked that question three times?

If Jesus asked you, "Do you love Me?"—what would you say, and why? Read [John 3:16](#).



Sometimes we all make bad choices and do things that are wrong. What should we do whenever we sin?

Read [1 John 1:9](#).

PRAY

Dear Lord Jesus, thank You for dying on the cross to forgive me for all of my sins and failures, and for rising from the grave to give me new life in You! Amen.

THE ANSWER

When Jesus said Peter would deny knowing Him, what did Peter say? **Read** [Matthew 26:33-35](#). Do you think Peter was bragging a little?

After Peter was forgiven, did he boast about his own power—or God's? **Read** [1 Peter 1:5](#).



What did Jesus mean when He told Peter to feed His sheep? **Read** [1 Peter 5:2-3](#).

After Peter was filled with the Holy Spirit, he was so changed that he fearlessly preached the Gospel to some of the same people who helped kill Jesus! **Read** [Acts 2:38](#). He also wrote two books of the Bible: 1 and 2 Peter.

Why do you think Peter talked a lot about God's grace, which is His special favor that we can never earn or deserve? **Read** [1 Peter 5:10-12](#).

PRAY

Thank You, Jesus, for the free gift of eternal life, which I can never earn by my own efforts. Help me share this Good News with others! Amen.
