Beloved Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We have hit the new ecclesiastical year running! This past month I cannot tell you how thrilled I have been to see our Saint Nicholas ministries launching, and the response these opening events have received from the faithful. Whether it is the youth retreats, the religious education offerings, the philanthropic and evangelical services of the Church, it is by way of these ministries that we are able to make the love of God *experiential* for our people. The only catch is that we need your help in making all of this possible, through your stewardship pledges.

It is by offering our blessings back to God that He will be able to continue His forgiving, healing, liberating, empowering, transfiguring, loving ministry through the Church. For God, Infinite though He is, has chosen to work through us, through our gifts, to continue His saving work in the world today. – Fr. Anthony M. Coniaris

God doesn't need our money. The Kingdom of Heaven will never be forced to shut its gates because of low stewardship returns. Where stewardship is needed is in the daily functioning of the parish. It is because of stewardship that we can provide our teachers with supplies and lesson plans to help raise our children in the faith. It is because of stewardship that we are able to run out to the hospitalized and home-bound at a moment's notice and touch their lives. And it is because of stewardship that we are able to have the very bread and wine for our weekly celebrations of the life-saving sacrament of the Eucharist!

So while, God freely offers His love to us from Heaven, many times our ability to experience it on earth is reliant on human means within the context of the Church.
